Step 1 — Final Thoughts



- The Nintendo Switch OLED Model earns a *7 out of 10* on our repairability scale (10 is the easiest to repair):
 - Most important components are modular and easy to replace.
 - Batteries, though adhered to their housings, are easy to access and disconnect, and not too difficult to remove.
 - The new OLED display is only adhered to the console around the edges, making replacements just as easy as the original Switch.
 - Some of the internal changes to the Switch OLED reduce the modularity of individual components.
 - Proprietary tri-point screws restrict users from opening the Switch.
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
